‘Dinner at Six’ sales fund York County Shelters

In an effort to raise awareness and money for the homeless, critically-acclaimed author, Helen Hudson (“Tell the Time to None,” “Farnsbee South,” “Criminal Trespass,” “Temporary Residence,” among others) has published a collection of powerful stories gleaned from her years as a soup kitchen volunteer, entitled, “Dinner at Six: voices from the soup kitchen.”

During her time in the downtown soup kitchens, Hudson became interested in the lives of the “Guests” and the circumstances that brought them to the food line.

The interviews she recorded presents a view of life that many do not even know exists. Her generous family graciously self-published the work and makes it available to homeless organizations to sell as a fundraiser. One hundred percent of the price of the book is retained by the homeless organizations.
